

I. Problem

Equable and polycentric society and economy ⇒

Complete and modern transport network ⇒

- ◆ **hierarchical structure,**
- ◆ **grid formation of the road network**

Hierarchical structure:

- ◆ Continental network
- ◆ National network
- ◆ Regional network
- ◆ Local network

Grid formation of the road network:


- ◆ Network-scale of 100-200 km
- ◆ North-south and West-east axles
- ◆ Topographical factors:
 - ◆ relief and river-system
 - ◆ large cities, industrial areas
 - ◆ traffic hubs and ports of great importance

Corridors or network?

- ◆ Lonely corridor is less effective.
- ◆ Single corridors are rivals of each other.
- ◆ For time being there is no system and institution to study, evaluate or implement of any proposed corridors

Solution:

International expert team
for network-planing.

II. Problem

Border crossing local roads


- ◆ Do the local roads crossing the state borders exist? And are they usable even now?
- ◆ Iron curtain \Rightarrow frontier zone \Rightarrow depopulation, desertation

Degradated districts in Hungary:

- ◆ 2243 km state border x 15 km frontier zone = 30.000 km²
- ◆ Adding with the other side of the border: 50.000 km²

Restricted frontier zones along the hungarian border zone

50.000 km²!



Consequences for Hungary

From the two north-east counties

- ◆ emigrated 90.000 people
- ◆ 90 schools are closed
- ◆ faltered society and dysfunctional state

(poste, shops, doctor, pharmacy, public order...)
